BY-LAW

Number 218 - 2017

To exempt from City taxation,
Land that is used and occupied by the Royal Canadian Legion
or any Army, Navy and Air Force Veterans Club

Repeals By-law 380-2007

WHEREAS Section 6.1 (1) of the *Assessment Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31 and amendments thereto, permits a municipality to exempt from taxation, other than school taxes or any fees or charges that have priority lien status including local improvement rates, for a period not exceeding ten (10) years, any land that is used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse, or athletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in any war;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to provide a tax exemption from City taxation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Treasurer is authorized to allow a tax exemption from City taxation on land used and occupied by the Royal Canadian Legion or of the Army, Navy, and Air Force Veterans Club, provided that:
 - 1.1. the land is used and occupied as a memorial house, clubhouse or athletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in war;
 - 1.2. the exemption does not include taxes levied for school purposes or the obligation to pay fees and charges that have priority lien status including local improvement rates.
2. That this By-law shall come into effect on January 1, 2018.
3. That By-law 380-2007 shall and is hereby repealed upon this by-law coming into effect.

4. That this By-law shall remain in force from year to year until repealed, but shall not remain in force after December 31, 2027.


