BY-LAW

Number 255 - 2017

To provide for information to be translated into other languages for the 2018 City of Brampton Municipal Election

WHEREAS Section 9(2)(b) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended ("Act") provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law allowing the use of French and other languages other than English in notices, forms (other than prescribed forms) and other information provided under the Act;

WHEREAS Council deems it appropriate to translate election information (other than prescribed forms) into languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the City of Brampton's population;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

That notices, forms (other than prescribed forms) and other information for the 2018 Municipal Election provided under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* be translated into French and other languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the population of the City of Brampton according to the most recent Census.
