

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number <u>266</u>-2017

To authorize the waiver of Section 42 requirements of the Expropriation Act to facilitate the disposal of surplus City owned land, municipally known as 1524 Countryside Drive – Ward 9

WHEREAS City staff were instructed to report to Committee of Council regarding a potential disposal of surplus City owned land that was acquired via Expropriation, being Parts 5 & 6 on Expropriation Plan – PR1675121 and municipally known as 1524 Countryside Drive

AND WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. E.26, as amended requires the City as the Expropriating Authority to provide the owners from whom land was taken the first chance to repurchase the lands on the terms of the best offer received by the Expropriating Authority for lands that have been expropriated, unless the approval of City Council as the Approving Authority is given;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT Council acting as the "Approving Authority" pursuant to the *Expropriations Act*, approves the disposal by the City as the "Expropriating Authority" of the lands municipally known as 1524 Countryside Drive and legally described as Parts 5 and 6, Plan PR1675121, without giving the owners from whom the lands were taken the first chance to repurchase the lands on the terms of the best offer received by the City, in accordance with Section 42 of the *Expropriations Act*.
