BY-LAW

Number 183 - 2018

To Amend Interim Control By-Law 246-2017 applicable to part of the area subject to Zoning By-law 270-2004.

WHEREAS Council adopted Interim Control By-law 246-2017 on November 8, 2017;

AND WHEREAS Interim Control By-law 246-2017 is set to expire one year from the date of its enactment;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 38(2) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended, the council of the municipality may amend an interim control by-law to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the interim control by-law;

AND WHEREAS an extension of Interim Control By-law 246-2017 is appropriate to allow time to complete the Queen Street Corridor Land Use Study and report to Council;


Now, therefore, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 246-2017, is amended by deleting from section 2 the words "one year" and replacing them with the words "two years".
