



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 152 - 2019

To appoint Deputy City Solicitors as Acting City Solicitor on a rotating basis, and to amend By-law 84-2008, as amended

WHEREAS By-law 84-2008 provides for the appointment of officials of The Corporation of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the position of City Solicitor will become vacant with the retirement of the City Solicitor as of July 19, 2019;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable that the two Deputy City Solicitors of the Corporation be appointed as Acting City Solicitor in rotation as hereinafter provided;

AND WHEREAS John Zingaro is Deputy City Solicitor, Real Property, Commercial and Development Law, and Diana Soos is Deputy City Solicitor, Litigation and Administrative Law;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That Section 12 clause (a) of By-law 84-2008, as amended, be deleted and replaced by the following:
 - 12 (a) (i) That John Zingaro and Diana Soos be appointed as Acting City Solicitor to carry out the duties of the City Solicitor while the position is vacant, on a rotating two (2) week basis respectively, starting with Diana Soos for the two week period commencing July 20 to August 2, 2019, and continuing with John Zingaro for the two week period commencing August 3 to 16, 2019, and alternating in like manner thereafter;
 - (ii) That should a Deputy City Solicitor be unable to carry out the duties of Acting City Solicitor for any time during a period of such appointment, the other Deputy City Solicitor shall serve as Acting City Solicitor in his or her stead for such time; and
 - (iii) That should neither Deputy City Solicitor be able to carry out the duties of Acting City Solicitor for any time during his or her appointment hereunder, the Chief Administrative Officer may appoint a legal counsel in the Legal Services division to serve as Acting City Solicitor during such time.


