# BY-LAW

Number 165 - 2019

To Appoint an Integrity Commissioner and Repeal By-law 50-2017

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WHEREAS sections 5, 8, 9 and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorize the Council to pass by-laws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes, and in particular paragraph 2 of subsection 11 (2) authorizes by-laws respecting the accountability and transparency of the municipality and its operations;

AND WHEREAS subsection 223.2 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides that a municipality shall establish codes of conduct for members of the council of the municipality and of local boards of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS subsection 223.3 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes municipalities to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who reports to Council and is responsible for performing in an independent manner the functions assigned by the municipality as set out in the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

AND WHEREAS by By-law Number 50-2017 passed on March 29, 2017, The Corporation of the City of Brampton appointed Guy Giorno, of the firm Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP, as the Integrity Commissioner for the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS Guy Giorno tendered his resignation as the City's Integrity Commissioner and by Council's Resolutions C062-2019 and C193-2019 passed March 6 and May 22, 2019 respectively, Suzanne Craig was appointed as the City's temporary Integrity Commissioner until such time as the City appointed a new Integrity Commissioner;

AND WHEREAS Council's Resolution C193-2019 passed May 22, 2019 also directed staff to initiate a recruitment process for the joint functional services of an Integrity Commissioner and Lobbyist Registrar, as set out in the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, and City by-laws.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

## **Appointment**

1. Council hereby establishes the Office of the Integrity Commissioner, and appoints Muneeza Sheikh as the Integrity Commissioner for the City of Brampton, with all powers, duties and protections provided under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.

**Short Title**

2. This By-law may be referred to as the "Integrity Commissioner By-law."


**In Force**

- 4. By-law 50-2017 is hereby repealed on the day this By-law comes into force.


