

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW Number 86 -2020

To authorize the approval and ratification of an agreement of purchase and sale for the disposal of a surplus City owned property, 1524 Countryside Drive, Ward 9 to Habitat for Humanity Greater Toronto Area.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to dispose the subject property in Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Agreement of Purchase and Sale accepted on February 24, 2020 between the City of Brampton and Habitat for Humanity Greater Toronto Area, for the sale of the City's lands municipally known as 1524 Countryside Drive, Brampton, legally described as Part of Lot 16, Concession 4 EHS Chinguacousy, described as parts of Parts 5 and 6 subject to an easement over part 6 on Expropriation Plan PR1675121, being part of PIN 14225-0107 (LT) is hereby approved and ratified;
- That the Commissioner of Community Services be authorized to execute any agreements or other documents necessary for the completion of the City's sale to Habitat for Humanity Greater Toronto Area of 1524 Countryside Drive, Brampton on terms acceptable to the Senior Manager

 Realty Services and in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor, or designate;
