Number MO 3-2020

A By-law to amend the Brampton COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law MO 1-2020

WHEREAS the World Health Organization has declared a worldwide pandemic regarding the Novel Coronavirus 19 ("COVID-19");

AND WHEREAS on March 17, 2020 the Province of Ontario declared an emergency pursuant to section 7.0.1 of the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.9 (the "*Emergency Management Act*") related to COVID-19;

AND WHEREAS section 4 of the *Emergency Management Act* provides that the head of council of a municipality may declare that an emergency exists in the municipality or in any part thereof and may take such action and make such orders as he or she considers necessary and are not contrary to law to implement the emergency plan of the municipality and to protect property and the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the emergency area;

AND WHEREAS on March 24, 2020 The Corporation of the City of Brampton declared an emergency pursuant to section 4 of the Emergency Management Act;

AND WHEREAS on March 31, 2020 the Brampton COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law was established pursuant to section 4 of the *Emergency Management Act* and affirmed by Council on April 9, 2020 (by Council Resolution C104-2020 and Confirming By-law 59-2020), to prohibit certain activities and regulate physical distancing during the COVID-19 emergency consistent with and in support of the Provincial emergency orders and regulation also established under the *Emergency Management Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. **THAT** the Brampton COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law MO 1-2020, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting subsection 4(f) of Schedule A and replacing it with the following:
 - (f) parking lots, except the Nelson Square Parking Garage (located at 2 Diplock Lane) and the George Street North Surface Parking (located at the corner of George St. North and Diplock Lane).
- 2. **THAT** in this and all other respects the Brampton COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law MO 1-2020, as amended, remains in effect.


