BY-LAW NUMBER 1 - 75


A By-law to accept and assume
lands as part of a public high-
way in the City of Brampton


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume lands
in conveyance from various parties as parts of public
highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City
of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described in deeds of conveyance to the
Corporation of the City of Brampton listed on
Schedule "A" hereto attached, be and the same, are
hereby dedicated
2. The lands listed and described on Schedule "A" hereto
attached are assumed and accepted as part of a public
highway and named as follows:
 - (a) Parcel described Firstly on
Schedule "A" - Church Street
 - (b) Parcel described Secondly on
Schedule "A" - 2nd Line West
of Hurontario Street
 - (c) Parcel described Thirdly on
Schedule "A" - Kennedy Road
 - (d) Parcel described Fourthly on
Schedule "A" - Glidden Road

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open
Council this 13th day of January, 1975.

Firstly - 280242VS

All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly in the Town of Brampton, in the County of Peel, being composed of part of Lot 101 on Registered Plan BR-2, being a subdivision of Part Lot 6, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, and part of the West half of Lot 6, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, described as follows:

PREMISING that the bearings herein are assumed to be astronomic and are referred to the North 45 degrees, 14 minutes, 30 seconds East of the Northerly limit of Church Street in accordance with a plan of survey by McLean, McMurchy and Biason, dated June 1, 1971.

COMMENCING at an iron bar in the North side of Church Street distant 211.20 feet Easterly from the most Southerly angle of Lot 101, Plan BR-2.

THENCE North 45 degrees, 14 minutes, 30 seconds East along the Northerly limit of Church Street, a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron bar.

THENCE North 39 degrees, 54 minutes West a distance of 6.62 feet.

THENCE South 45 degrees, 14 minutes 30 seconds West, a distance of 150.56 feet.

THENCE South 44 degrees, 13 minutes East, a distance of 6.60 feet to the point of commencement.

Herein described parcel contains an area of 0.023 acres.

Secondly - 325661VS

All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, County of Peel, and Province of Ontario containing by admeasurement an area of 0.064 acres more or less and being composed of part of Lot 2, Concession 3, West of Hurontario Street of the said Township, the limits of which said parcel of land may be more particularly described as follows:

PREMISING that the Northeasterly limit of said Lot 2, Concession 3, West of Hurontario Street has an astronomic bearing of North 44 degrees, 35 minutes 30 seconds West and relating all bearings herein thereto;

COMMENCING at a survey monument in the Northeasterly limit of said Lot 2 distant 125.00 feet measured Southeasterly thereon from the most Northerly angle thereof;

THENCE South 44 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds East along said Northeasterly limit 160.71 feet to a survey monument at the intersection of the Northwesterly limit of the lands of the Canadian Pacific Railway;

THENCE South 58 degrees 32 minutes 10 seconds West along said Northwest-erly limit 125.00 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE North 44 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds East 114.75 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE North 44 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds West 130.00 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE North 45 degrees 24 minutes 30 seconds East 7.00 feet to the Point of Commencement.

Thirdly - 337904VS

All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly in the Town of Brampton, in the County of Peel, and being composed of that part of the East Half of Lot 7, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the original Township of Chinguacousy designated as Part 1 according to a Reference Plan deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 43R-2274.

Fourthly - 286077VS

All and Singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Town of Brampton, in the County of Peel are being parts of Lot 2 in the Second Concession East of Hurontario Street, more particularly described as follows:

Parcel 1 - being the whole of Part 3 according to a Reference Plan deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number 43R-613, and

Parcel 2 - being the whole of Part 3 according to a Reference Plan deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number 43R-383.
