as part of Torbram Road;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, in the County of Peel), being composed of part of the West half of Lot 8, Concession 6, East of Hurontario Street, more particularly described as follows:

PREMISING that the northeasterly limit of the road allowance between Concessions 5 and 6, has an astronomic bearing of North 44 degrees, 3 minutes, 20 seconds West, in accordance with a plan of survey by John D. Barnes, Ontario Land Surveyor dated October 25, 1968, and attached to an instrument registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as number 89717V.S., and relating all bearings herein thereto;

COMMENCING at a point in the southwesterly limit of said Lot 8, a distance of 866.08 feet measured South 44 degrees, 3 minutes, 20 seconds East, along the said southwesterly limit from the most westerly angle thereof;

THENCE continuing South 44 degrees, 3 minutes, 20 seconds East, along the said southwesterly limit 150 feet to a point;

THENCE North 39 degrees, 43 minutes, 40 seconds East, 17.10 feet to a survey monument in a line drawn parallel to the said southwesterly limit and distant 17 feet measured northeasterly therefrom and at right angles thereto;

THENCE North 44 degrees, 3 minutes, 20 seconds West, 150 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE South 39 degrees, 43 minutes, 40 seconds West, 17.10 feet to the point of commencement.

The hereindescribed parcel of land is further shown outlined as Part 12 on a plan of survey prepared by John D. Barnes, Ontario Land Surveyor dated October 25, 1968, and attached to an instrument registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as number 89717V.S.
