BY-LAW

Number 4-82

To amend By-law 861, as amended,
of the former Township of
Chinguacousy, now in the City of
Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 861, as specifically amended by By-laws 229-80, 11-81, and 253-81,
is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting section 16J, subsection (3)(o) and substituting therefor
the following:

"(o) For each motor vehicle washing establishment there shall be
provided 10 waiting spaces arranged on the site so as to
provide continuous access to the entrance of the motor
vehicle washing establishment.

(p) The minimum size of a waiting space shall be 2.75 metres by 6
metres."


(2) by deleting section 16K, subsection (2)(o) and substituting therefor
the following:


"(o) For each motor vehicle washing establishment there shall be
provided 10 waiting spaces arranged on the site so as to
provide continuous access to the entrance of the motor
vehicle washing establishment.

(p) The minimum size of a waiting space shall be 2.75 metres by 6
metres."
