To establish the City of Brampton
Safety Council and to establish the
terms of reference for the City of
Brampton Safety Council.


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as
follows:

1. There shall be a sub-committee of the Public Works Committee
to be known as the Safety Council of the City of Brampton and
it shall be composed of the following:
 - a) Five persons who are not members of City Council or
Regional Council or a local Board as defined in section
1(c) of the Municipal Affairs Act (R.S.O. 1980 c. 303,
as amended), all of whom shall be appointed annually
by Resolution of City Council.
 - b) One Trustee each from the Peel Board of Education and
the Dufferin Peel Roman Catholic Separate School Board.
 - c) One member of City Council to be appointed annually by
Resolution of Council.
 - d) One staff representative from each of the following:
 - Peel Regional Police Force Safety Division
 - City of Brampton Public Works Department
 - Peel Board of Education
 - Dufferin Peel Roman Catholic Separate School Board
 - School Bus Operators Association
2. Each member of the Safety Council shall hold office during
the calendar year in which he or she is appointed and until
his or her successor is appointed.

3. At the first meeting of the Safety Council each year, after the appointments have been made, the members thereof shall elect from among their number a Chairman and Vice-Chairman.
4.
 - a) The Safety Council shall meet once each month if required.
 - b) By-law 62-81 as amended applies with necessary modifications to meetings of the Safety Council.
5. The Safety Council shall consider matters which relate directly to school safety concerns and pedestrian education. The objectives and responsibilities of the Safety Council shall be:
 - a) To consider the advisability of and to co-ordinate student school bus and street patroller programs and to advise on matters relating thereto.
 - b) To consider and advise upon matters relating to school route, school bus and bicycle safety.
 - c) To assist with safety programs conducted both in and outside the schools promoting pedestrian education.
 - d) To review existing and prospective new adult school guard stations, employing approved warrant criteria and recommend additions or deletions to system as required.
 - e) To report on and refer to appropriate City and Regional departments, School Boards, Police Divisions, etc. any other matters related to school safety requiring the application of Engineering standards and warrants, specialized expertise or enforcement.
 - f) The Safety Council shall report to the Public Works Committee of the City Council and any recommendations forwarded by the Safety Council to the Public Works Committee shall be accompanied by all technical reports commissioned by, submitted to and considered by the Safety Council.
6.
 - a) The Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of Brampton is hereby designated as Treasurer of the Safety Council.


- b) The Safety Council shall prepare annual estimates of programs and funds required to support those programs and submit its estimates in January of each year and shall make such further information and representation as Council may require in its consideration of those programs and estimates.
