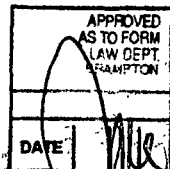
To establish certain lands as
part of public highways


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to establish certain lands as public highway system.


NOT THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:
