



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 5-82

To amend By-law 5500, as amended, of the former Town of Mississauga now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 5500, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting section 96B, subsection (3)(o) and substituting therefor the following:

"(o) For each motor vehicle washing establishment there shall be provided 10 waiting spaces arranged on the site so as to provide continuous access to the entrance of the motor vehicle washing establishment.

(p) The minimum size of a waiting space shall be 2.75 metres by 6 metres."


(2) by deleting section 96C, subsection (2)(o) and substituting therefor the following:


"(o) For each motor vehicle washing establishment there shall be provided 10 waiting spaces arranged on the site so as to provide continuous access to the entrance of the motor vehicle washing establishment.

(p) The minimum size of a waiting space shall be 2.75 metres by 6 metres."
