The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-Law 274-2004, as amended by By-Law 314-2004, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - 1 Section 1 is amended by adding, before the words "The lands described as part of Lot 6, Concession 1, E.H.S.," the following:
 - "Except as provided for in Section 1.2,"
 - 2. The following is added as Section 1.2:

270-2004.

- "1.2 The lands described as the easterly half of part of Lot 40, Block 3, Plan BR-4 and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption from Interim Control By-Law 274-2004", as amended by By-Law 5 as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall permit a parking lot."
- 3. Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.


