Being a by-law By-law 139-80,		

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Subsection (1) of Section 9 of By-law 139-80, as amended is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:
 - 9(1) Plans examination fees as set out in Schedule A to this by-law are payable when an application for a permit is submitted.
- 2. Subsection (5) of Section 9 of By-law 139-80, as amended is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:
 - 9(5) Where continuous or special inspection is required, or when the applicant requests any inspection in other than normal business hours in connection with any matter, the fee shall be as set out in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 3. Schedule A to By-law 139-80, as amended, is hereby repealed and the attached Schedule A substituted therefor.

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SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW # CLASSES OF PERMITS & PERMIT FEES

Class or type of permit

Permit fee

 Construction, or reconstruction of a building (including additions, foundations, garages, carports, accessory buildings.) \$7.00 for each \$1000.00 of the cost of the work. (Minimum \$15.00)

Plus a plans examination charge, calculated in accordance with the table below.

Plus a final inspection charge as in the table below.

4. Installation of a storage tank having a capacity of 1000 gallons, or more.

\$25.00 for each tank.

\$5.00 for each pump.

5. Installation of gasoline pumps

Erection and construction of a temporary building

 Installation of any type of heating system \$25.00.

\$15.00 Plus \$7.00 for each 10.000 btu/hr of building heat loss, or part thereof up to a total of 1 million btu/hr heat loss, and \$3.00 for each 10,000 btu/hr of building heat loss thereafter.

 Alterations or additions to, or replacement of, existing heating system, where building is altered or expanded. \$15.00 Plus \$7.00 for each 10,000 btu/hr of building heat loss; or part thereof, calculated on the building addition, or on the part the heating system serves.

Installation of independent space heater, or pool heater.

\$15.00 each.

10. Replacement or renewal of furnace


\$15.00 each.

 Installation of conversion burner or add-on heat pump.

\$15.00 each.

12. Continuous, or Special Inspection
 (Where required)

\$25.00 per hour or any part thereof.
