
## BY-LAW

To amend By-law 861, as amended by By-law 195-75 and 331-79 (Part Lot 5, Concession 3, E.H.S.)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 861, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-laws 195-75 and 331-79, is hereby further amended;
  - (1) by adding thereto, as SITE PLAN FOR BY-LAW 195-75 LANDS NO. 2, Schedule A to this by-law,
  - (2) by deleting therefrom section 4.1, as set out in By-law 195-75 and amended by By-law 331-79, and substituting therefor the following:
    - "4.1 The lands shown as RM4 on Schedule A to this by-law shall only be used for the following purposes:
      - (1) apartment house dwellings;
      - (2) a school;
      - (3) a religious institution;
      - (4) a public library;
      - (5) a convenience grocery store;
      - (6) a laundry or dry cleaning receiving and delivery depot, and
      - (7) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes.
  - (3) by adding thereto, as section 4.6, the following:
    - "4.6 (1) The convenience grocery store and the laundry or dry cleaning receiving and delivery depot shall be located within the area shown as COMMERCIAL AREA on SITE PLAN FOR BY-LAW 195-75 LANDS NO. 2.
