AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93- 26
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE
CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 24: Fletchers Creek South, Amendment Number 257A to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

2.0 Location:

The lands subject to this amendment are located on the north side of Ray Lawson Boulevard, at the intersection of Timberlane Drive.

3.0 Amendments and Policies Relative Thereto:

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- (1) by adding, to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 24: Fletchers Creek South, as set out in Part II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number 257A to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.
