	 those parts of Lots 360, 364, 365, 370, 371, 372, 376, 377, and 378 on Registered Plan 43M-1068, designated as Parts 8 on Reference Plan 43R-19982 and Parts 1 to 8, both inclusive on Reference Plan 43R- 20796
2.	This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel.
