BY-LAW

Number 17-85

To prevent the application of Part Lot Control of certain lands within Brampton (Bramalea Limited)

WHEREAS subsection 49 (5) of the Planning Act, 1983, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49 (7) of the Planning Act, 1983, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of Section 49 of the Planning Act, 1983, does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW 17-85

FIRSTLY

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, and being composed of the whole of Lots 1 to 92, both inclusive, according to a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number M-552.

SECONDLY

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, and being composed of the whole of Lots 1 to 51, both inclusive, according to a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number M-556.
