BY-LAW

Number 18-83

A By-Law to make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day

WHEREAS, the Brams United Girls Soccer Club propose to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by the Brams United Girls Soccer Club at 291 Rutherford Road South, Brampton "SKATE COUNTRY".
- 2. The activities specified in Paragraph 1 of this By-Law shall be limited to the period between 7:30 P.M. and 10:30 P.M., in the afternoon of each Sunday, the dates of which are set out in Schedule 'A' hereto. The times referred to in this paragraph shall be deemed to mean Eastern Standard Time or Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable in the City of Brampton on the dates set out in Schedule 'A' hereto;
- 3. All activities permitted by this By-Law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
