WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of "Henlark Court" as shown on Registered Plan 43M-520;




AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;
