## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 19-75

A By-law to amend By-law No. 14-74, being a By-law passed pursuant to the Planning Act R.S.O, c. 349, sec. 38, to, inter alia, regulate the construction, erection or repair of buildings.

WHEREAS the Planning Act R.S.O. 1970, c. 349, sec. 38, par. 24 authorizes the Councils of Municipalities to adopt by By-law in whole or in part the National Building Code of Canada, with such changes as Council may consider necessary and;

WHEREAS By-law 14-74 in Section 2, Subsection 2.6 adopted Part 9 of the National Building Code and;

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the aforesaid Section. Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. That Section 2, Sub-section 2.6, Page 385, Item 9.23.15.5. in By-law 14-74 is amended to read as follows:

"That 3/8" plywood be used on roofs having 12", 16", 20" and 24" centres of rafters or trusses. 20" and 24" centres must have two H clips spaced evenly at the edge of each sheet between trusses or rafters. 20" and 24" centres of rafters or trusses must have all roof openings for vent stacks etc., properly braced around the openings. In all cases the plywood sheets must be of 4' x 8' size and ventilation shall be 1/300 minimum. All plywoods used for roof sheathing must be stamped on the face of each individual sheet to identify the Mill and that the material is for exterior use."
