

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 20-84
To amend By-law 63-82, as amended
(licensing of adult entertainment
parlours)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 7 of By-law 63-82, as amended, is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:
 - "7. In addition to the provisions of any by-law passed by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton under authority of paragraph 141 of section 210 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended), or any predecessor thereto, the following provisions apply to signs or advertising devices used for the purpose of promoting an adult entertainment parlour:
 - (1) No person shall erect, or display, or cause to be erected or displayed, a sign or advertising device used for the purpose of promoting an adult entertainment parlour other than the following:
 - (a) an awning or canopy sign
 - , (b) a wall or fascia sign.
 - (2) No person shall erect, or display, or cause to be erected or displayed, a sign or advertising device used for the purpose of promoting


an adult entertainment parlour, where such sign or advertising device:

- (a) has any animation,
- (b) has flashing lights,
- (c) conveys a message through the use of pictures, graphics or any means other than by the use of words, or
- (d) is designed to revolve on an axis.
- (3) For the purpose of this section, "animation" shall mean any motion of a display or part thereof whether by mechanical action or the flashing on and off of its lights.
- (4) Where there is a conflict between the provisions of this by-law and the provisions of any by-law passed by the Council of the City under authority of paragraph 141 of section 210 of the Municipal Act, or any predecessor thereto, the provisions of this by-law shall apply."
- 2. Section 16 of By-law 63-82 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
 - "(i) permit any person to provide services in an adult
 entertainment parlour unless the person providing
 the services is wearing opaque clothing which fully
 covers his or her pubic area."
