BY-LAW

Number 22-89

To amend by-law 102-74
(regulating and prohibiting
the discharge of firearms)

WHEREAS By-law 102-74 regulates the discharge of firearms within the City of Brampton.

AND WHEREAS Section 6 of By-law 102-74 provides for exemptions from the By-law's application, and Section 7 provides for penalty;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporaton of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 102-74 is hereby amended by deleting Section 6 thereof and substituting therefor the following:


"6. Nothing in this By-law is intended to prohibit the use of guns by any Animal Control Officers employed by the Corporation of the City of Brampton, or any Policemen, Guards, Servicemen or other Peace Officers authorized to use guns by any Provincial, Federal or Municipal Act.

2. By-law 102-74 is hereby further amended by deleting Section 7 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"7. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding the sum of \$2000.00 for each offence exclusive of costs.


