# BY-LAW

Number 25-91

To change the name of  
McMurchy Lane

---

**WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of McMurchy Lane;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of Council's intention to pass this by-law was advertised once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, the particulars of which are set out in the affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich which forms part of this by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has heard all persons who claimed they would be adversely affected by this by-law; and who applied to be heard;


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of McMurchy Lane, which is comprised of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law; is changed to Diplock Lane.
2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.


I, Leonard J. Mikulich, City Clerk and Director of Administration for The Corporation of the City of Brampton, MAKE OATH AND SAY:
