To change the name o	of

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of McMurchy Lane;

AND WHEREAS notice of Council's intention to pass this by-law was advertised once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, the particulars of which are set out in the affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich which forms part of this by-law;

AND WHEREAS Council has heard all persons who claimed they would be adversely affected by this by-law; and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The name of McMurchy Lane, which is comprised of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law; is changed to Diplock Lane.
- 2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11 day of February, 1991.
