



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 25-95

To amend By-law 86-77

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law No. 86-77 regarding the membership of the Board of Management of the Brampton Downtown Business Association.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Sections (3) and (5) of By-law No. 86-77, as amended, are deleted and the following Sections are substituted therefor:
 - (3) The Board shall be appointed by Council and shall consist of the following classes and numbers of Directors:
 - (i) At least one (1) member of Council;
 - (ii) An employee of the Treasury Services Division of the City of Brampton as the City's nominee and to be appointed Treasurer; and
 - (iii) No less than ten (10) and no more than fifteen (15) individuals assessed for business assessment in respect of the land in the Area or nominees of such individuals or corporations so assessed.
 - (5) Where a vacancy occurs from any cause:
 - (i) The Board shall notify Council forthwith and the Board shall be entitled to continue to act provided that a quorum is present;
 - (ii) Subject to Section (5) (iii) Council may appoint a person qualified as set out in section (3) to be a member who shall hold office for the remainder of the term for which his or her predecessor was appointed;

(iii)

If, as a result of the vacancy, the number of directors in any of the classes referred to in Section (3) falls below the minimum number required for that class, the Council shall appoint a person qualified as set out in Section (3) to be a member who shall hold office for the remainder of the term for which his or her predecessor was appointed.
