

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

To establish a community recreation centre at Chassel's Pit

WHEREAS section 2(1) of <u>The Community Recreation</u> <u>Centres Act, S.O. 1974</u>, Chapter 80, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a community recreation centre in accordance with the said Act.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is desirous of establishing a community recreation centre on the land more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1.

A community recreation centre, comprised of a softball diamond, soccer field, multi-purpose community hall and lounge, snack bar, beach facilities and playing field is hereby established to be maintained, operated and financed by The Corporation of the City of Brampton pursuant to the provisions of <u>The Community Recreation</u> <u>Centres Act, 1974</u>, on the land more particularly described on Schedule "A" attached hereto.

2.

This community recreation centre shall be known as the "Chassel's Pit Recreation Centre".

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.
