BY-LAW

Number 26-2002

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of
Registered Plan 43M-1471, 43M-1404, 43M-1416, 43M-1489, 43M-1400

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

I. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act, does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

- Lots 2 to 11 inclusive, 16, 18, 19, 29 to 45 inclusive, 47 to 61 inclusive, 63, 64, 66 to 80 inclusive, 82, 83, 85, 87 to 96 inclusive, 98, 99, 101, 103 to 107 inclusive on Registered Plan 43M-1471, and Blocks 108, 109, 115 and 118 on Registered Plan 43M-1471
- Blocks 34 to 39 inclusive on Registered Plan 43M-1404
- Lot 72 on Registered Plan 43M-1416
- Blocks 24 and 26 on Registered Plan 43M-1489
- Lot 3 on Registered Plan 43M-1400
