



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 27-90

To authorize the establishment and operation of the Centennial Recreation and Senior Citizens Centre as an Elderly Persons Centre

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it advisable to establish and operate an Elderly Persons Centre in the City of Brampton on the lands more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto pursuant to Section 3 of The Elderly Persons Centres Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 131.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. An Elderly Persons Centre is hereby established to be operated by The Corporation of the City of Brampton on the lands more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto in accordance with The Elderly Persons Centres Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 131.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to give effect hereto.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the approval of the Ontario Minister of Community and Social Services given pursuant to The Elderly Persons Centres Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 131, as amended.

SCHEDULE A

The lands situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel) being the part of park Lots 9, 10, 13, 14 and 18 according to a plan of part of the west half of Lot 5 in the First Concession, East of Hurontario Street in the Geographic Township of Chinguacousy executed by Charles J. Wheelock, P.L.S., dated May, 1871 and registered on the 3rd day of June, 1871 and referred to as Plan BR-21, more particularly described as follows:

PREMISING that the southwesterly limit of the Kings Highway No. 10 as widened has an assumed astronomic bearing of North $43^{\circ}57'30''$ W in accordance with the D.H.O. Plan P-2002-23 (referred to the meridian through the southerly corner of Lot 15, Concession 2, NDS, in the Township of Toronto longitude $79^{\circ}37'30''$ W) and relating all bearings herein thereto;

COMMENCING at the westerly angle of Lot 9, Plan BR-21;

THENCE North $38^{\circ}35'20''$ E along the northwesterly limit of Lot 9, 13.00 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE South $51^{\circ}25'20''$ E 416.62 feet to the point of commencement;

THENCE $N9^{\circ}9'10''$ E 84.5 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $N11^{\circ}26'50''$ E 142.62 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $N1^{\circ}38'0''$ E 76.46 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $N16^{\circ}28'20''$ E 187.64 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $S72^{\circ}24'50''$ E 335.88 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $S43^{\circ}20'50''$ E 244.38 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE $S38^{\circ}27'10''$ W along the southerly limit of registered plan BR-21 a distance of 455.05 feet to a survey monument;

THENCE North $51^{\circ}25'20''$ W 247.3 feet to a point of commencement.
