# BY-LAW

Number 27-94

To further amend By-law 141-92  
(the Cemetery By-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 141-92 as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following as subsection 38(4):

"38(4) Despite section 36 of this By-law, only a granite flat marker having dimensions of 50.8cm X 30.48cm X 10.16cm shall be permitted for the cremation plots in Lots 1 to 48, Range D-4, of the Brampton Cemetery, showing the lot number and all requested inscriptions. The marker shall be made of Laurentian pink granite with steeled face finish, sown back and rock edges. The inscription on the marker shall be a sunken lettering with black litho paint.

2. Schedule B to By-law 141-92 as amended is hereby deleted and replaced by Schedule A to this By-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this 14th day of February , 1994.
