BY-LAW

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1853

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating lots for semi-detached dwelling lots and an associated maintenance easement and creating maintenance easements on single detached dwelling lots, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 2, 3, 4 and Blocks 34, 35 and 38 on Registered Plan 43M-1853 for the purposes of creating maintenance easements for single detached dwelling lots and the whole of Lot 14 on Registered Plan 43M-1853 for the purpose of creating a maintenance easement for semi-detached dwelling lot and the whole of Lots 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26 and Block 36 on Registered Plan 43M-1853 for the purpose of creating semi-detached dwelling unit lots.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on February 8, 2015.
