BY-LAW

Number 28-81

To establish a community
recreation centre at
Professor's Lake.

WHEREAS section 2(1) of The Community Recreation Centres Act, S.O. 1974, Chapter 80, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a community recreation centre in accordance with the said Act.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is desirous of establishing a community recreation centre on the land more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. A community recreation centre, comprised of a Community Hall, multi-purpose crafts rooms, lounge, boathouse and docks, beach facilities and change rooms is hereby established to be maintained, operated and financed by The Corporation of the City of Brampton pursuant to the provisions of The Community Recreation Centres Act, 1974, on the land more particularly described on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. This community recreation centre shall be known as the "Professor's Lake Recreation Centre".

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of January 1981.



ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of Land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chingaucousy in the County of Peel) and being composed of that part of Block G of Registered Plan M-282 of the City of Brampton, more particularly designated as part of Part 1 on a Plan of Survey deposited in the Registry Office for the Region of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 43R-2039.
