# BY-LAW

*Number* 30-83  
To temporarily close a portion of  
Main Street North

---

WHEREAS paragraph 44 of section 208 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, as amended) authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws for closing to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis for such period as shall be specified in the by-law any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the council for such social, recreational, community or athletic purpose, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Board of Management of the Four Corners Improvement Area desires to hold a winter carnival on a portion of Main Street North on Friday, February 11, 1983 and Saturday, February 12, 1983;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That during the winter carnival being held by the Board of Management of the Four Corners Improvement Area between the hours of 6:00 p.m. on Friday, February 11, 1983 and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 12, 1983, Main Street North from the North side of Queen Street to the South side of Nelson Street shall be closed to vehicular traffic.

2. That between the hours of 6:00 p.m. on Friday, February 11, 1983 at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 12, 1983, parking on Main Street North from Queen Street to Nelson Street shall be prohibited.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 24th day of January, 1983.
