

as Road Allowance

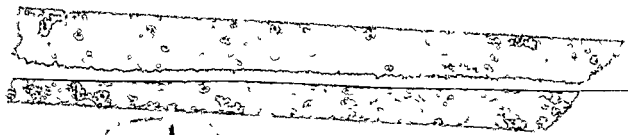
The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton

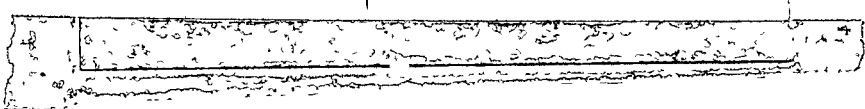
