AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93-49
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE
CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 7: Brampton Central, Amendment Number 280 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

2.0 Location:

The lands subject to this amendment are located on the south-west corner of the intersection of Railroad Street and Mill Street North. The lands have an area of approximately 1.2 hectares (3 acres).

3.0 Amendments and Policies Relative Thereto:

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:
