- SECONDLY: the whole of the part of Macassa Court shown on said Registered Plan M-102, and
- THIRDLY: the whole of the part of Pontiac Court shown on said Registered Plan M-102, and
- FOURTHLY: the whole of the part of Kindle Court shown on said Registered Plan M-102, and
- FIFTHLY: the whole of the part of Maraboo Court shown on said Registered Plan M-102.


