the transfer of lands

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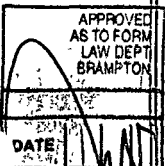
The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton

3. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute the transfer of these lands in a form approved by the City Solicitor, together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the said transfer of lands
