The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
- (1) by changing on Sheet 30 of Schedule "A" thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule "A" to this bylaw from AGRICULTURE (A) and RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY C SECTION 1050 (R1C Section 1050) to INSTITUTIONAL ONE (II).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 11th day of February 2002.


