Number 41-2010

A by-law to provide for voter information to be translated into other languages for City of Brampton Municipal Elections

WHEREAS Section 9(2) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law allowing the use of French and other languages other than English on information provided to voters;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That voter information for elections conducted under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* be translated into those languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the population of the City of Brampton according to the most recent Census, plus French.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of February, 2010.
