
To accept and assume a certain
part of Monte Vista Trail


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume a certain part of Monte Vista Trail as a public highway;

1. The land described in Schedule A to this by-law be and the same is hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.

The land situated in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy in the County of Peel), and being composed of that part of Monte Vista Trail shown on a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number M-113, designated as Parts 40, 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45, inclusive, on a reference plan in the said Land Registry Office as Number 43R-8492.
