BY-LAW

Number 43-83

To amend By-law 200-82, as amended.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY B (R1B) to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY C (R1C), such lands being part of Lot 6, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the former Town of Brampton, and
 - (2) by deleting Sheet 11 of Schedule A thereto, and substituting therefor Schedule B to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and Passed in Open Council

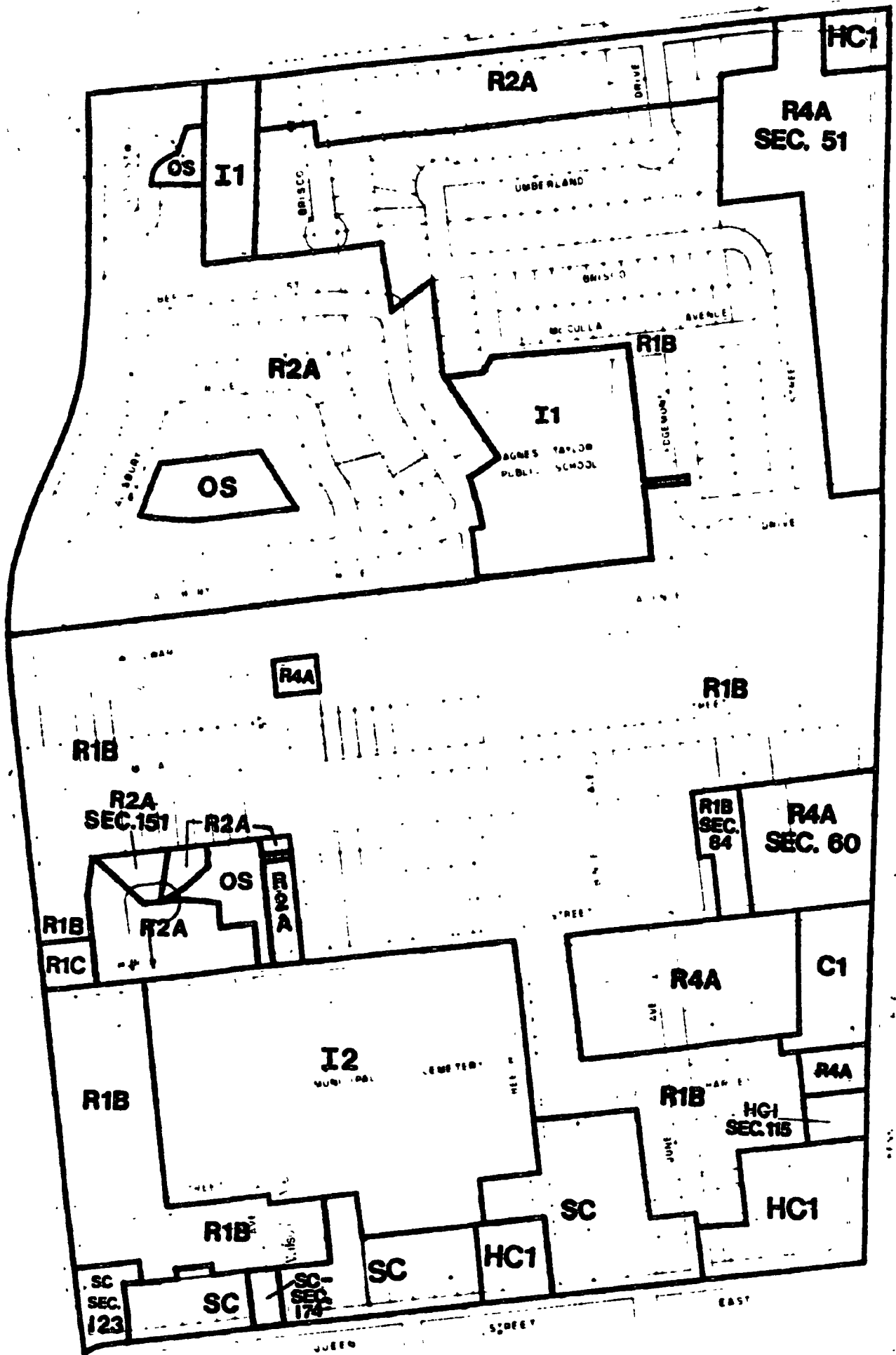


