

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 46-2003

To stop up and close part of Adelaide Street

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that Part of Adelaide Street as laid out on Plan TOR-11 described as Part 1 on Plan 43R-27861 be stopped up and closed;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published at least five days prior to the Council meeting at which this By-law is being considered in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton, as per s.34(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* and City of Brampton By-law 393-2002;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

1. The part of Adelaide Street as laid out on Plan TOR-11 described as Part 1 on Plan 43R-27861 is hereby stopped up and closed.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this  $24^{th}$  day of February, 2003.


