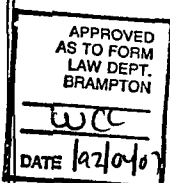


To authorize the granting of assistance to elderly residents of the City of Brampton pursuant to The Municipal Elderly Residents' Assistance Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.M.52 and to repeal By-law 46-74


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law "owner" means a person assessed as the owner of residential real property, and includes an owner within the meaning of the Condominium Act.
2. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to allow the credit hereinafter mentioned to the persons specified in subsection (1) of section 2 of The Municipal Elderly Residents' Assistance Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.M.52, who qualify under that subsection.
3. The credit against the real property taxes imposed by the municipality shall be a sum equal to the total amount levied in respect of the real property taxes of the owner for school purposes in the year the application for the credit is made.
4. Notwithstanding section 1 hereof, no owner who otherwise qualified shall receive a credit unless such owner or the spouse of such owner or both is or are receiving a monthly guaranteed income supplement under Part II of The Old Age Security Act (Canada).
5. The Treasurer is hereby directed to only allow the credit where he has received an application for the credit by the 31st day of December in the tax year in respect of which the application has been made.
6. By-law 46-74 is hereby repealed.
