## **BY-LAW**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the land described as Lot 62 on Plan 43M-1613 (the "Lands") be reconveyed to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed to the City for nominal consideration by the owner of the abutting lands and the City no longer requires the Lands and has agreed to reconvey the Lands to Taccpar North Developments Inc.;

**AND WHEREAS** the subdivision agreement between Taccpar North Developments Inc., the City and the Region dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2003 provided for the reconveyance of the Lands when the Lands are no longer required for temporary emergency access purposes;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. That the Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The transfer for nominal consideration of the Lands to Taccpar North Developments Inc. is hereby authorized and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the Lands.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD** TIME and **PASSED** in Open Council this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2005.
