the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part
lot control does not apply to lands within such registered
plans of parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of
Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act,
does not apply to the land that is described in
Schedule A to this by-law.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval
thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.
