BY-LAW

Number 52-92

To further amend By-law 193-83 (the regulation of traffic), as amended for the placement of an ALL WAY STOP on Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following item:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>BETWEEN</u>
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Chinguacousy Road and the west limit of Main Street South

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following item:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>BETWEEN</u>
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Chinguacousy Road and the west limit of Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection) and the west limit of Main Street South

(4) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IX thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>FACING TRAFFIC</u>
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)	Northbound on Moffatt Avenue
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)	Southbound on Torrance Woods
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)	Westbound on Charolais Boulevard
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)	Eastbound on Charolais Boulevard


This by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.



To further amend By-law 197-B1 (the regulation of traffic), as amended for the placement of an ALL WAY STOP on Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 197-B1, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Chinguacousy Road and the west limit of Main Street South

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Chinguacousy Road and the west limit of Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection)
Charolais Boulevard	The east limit of Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (easterly intersection) and the west limit of Main Street South

4) by adding to the existing columns of Schedule I
thereof the following items:



<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>PAVING IDEAL</u>
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (east/south intersection)	Northbound on Moffatt Avenue
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (west/south intersection)	Southbound on Torrance Woods
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (west/south intersection)	Westbound on Charolais Boulevard
Charolais Boulevard and Moffatt Avenue/Torrance Woods (west/south intersection)	Eastbound on Charolais Boulevard

This by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.




