	To amend By-law 4-83, as amended, respecting the City of Brampton Safety Council

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 4-83, which established and created terms of reference and the composition of the City of Brampton Safety Council;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Recommendation SC022-2002, approved by Council on February 25, 2002, it is deemed expedient to increase the membership of the Brampton Safety Council to include representation from Brampton Fire and Emergency Services;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- By-law 4-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - By deleting Section 1. d) and substituting therefor the following: (1)
 - "d) One staff representative from each of the following:
 - Peel Regional Police Regional Traffic Unit
 - City of Brampton Works and Transportation Department
 - Student Transportation Office, Peel District School Board/Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board
 - Brampton Fire and Emergency Services."
