BY-LAW

Number 62-2003

To authorize surplus lands and
transfer of an easement

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer an easement over Part of Block 274, Plan 43M-1300 designated as Parts 1 to 4 on Plan 43R-27910 (the "Lands") to The Regional Municipality of Peel;

AND WHEREAS the Lands are required as a condition of subdivision approval;

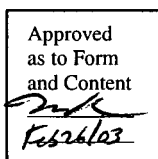
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Part of Block 274, Plan 43M-1300 designated as Parts 1 to 4 on Plan 43R-27910 is hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over Part of Block 274, Plan 43M-1300 designated as Parts 1 to 4 on Plan 43R-27910 to The Regional Municipality of Peel is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of March, 2003.

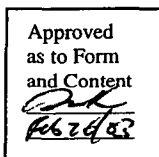
CERTIFICATE


Subsection 268(6) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25

I, **LEONARD J. MIKULICH**, of the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, hereby certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. I am employed as City Clerk for The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such, I have knowledge of the facts herein contained.
2. On March 10, 2003, the Council of the City of Brampton passed a by-law declaring surplus Part of Block 274, Plan 43M-1300 designated as Parts 1 to 4 on Plan 43R-27910 and authorizing a Transfer of Easement to The Regional Municipality of Peel.
3. Procedural by-law 7-2003, as required under subsection 268(1) was in force in the municipality at the time the by-law required by subsection 268(3) was passed.
